AGENDA: PROMOTION OF INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION IN DISASTER MANAGEMENT WORLDWIDE

The United Nations Office for Disaster Risk Reduction, earlier known as the International Strategy for Disaster Reduction (ISDR), is a global framework established within the United Nations for the promotion of action to decrease social vulnerability & natural hazards risk and associated technological and environmental disasters. Established within the United Nations for promoting action to decrease social vulnerability and natural hazards risks and related technological and environmental disasters. The United Nations International Strategy for Disaster Reduction now in its current form is known as the United Nations Office for Disaster Risk Reduction (UNDRR). It builds upon the experience gained during 1990- 1999 which had been designated as the International Decade for Natural Disaster Reduction. The UNDRR incorporates the principles which were adopted in the above-mentioned Decade including the Yokohama Strategy for a Safer World: Guidelines for Natural Disaster Prevention, Preparedness and Mitigation and its Plan of Action, and the Geneva Mandate on Disaster Reduction.

The United Nations Commission on Science and Technology for Development (CSTD) is the United Nations' home for discussions on science and technology - what is new, what matters, what is changing, what the impact is - and how this affects development and a sustainable future for all. It is the forum that helps ask and frame the critical issues influencing the fields of science and technology today. Some of the important normative issues raised include the technology and life interface, as well as governance of the use and development of frontier technologies - namely, big data analytics, biotech and genome editing, the Internet of things (IoT) and artificial intelligence. The CSTD is also an open platform where proposals, ideas, experiences, cases, and intellectual thought can be channelled toward making a policy impact. It facilitates concrete collaborations between member states, NGOs and actors in the science, technology and development space.

Welcome to Blue Bells MUN 2023, UNCSTD committee. Together, let's explore the limitless potential of science and technology to shape a better tomorrow

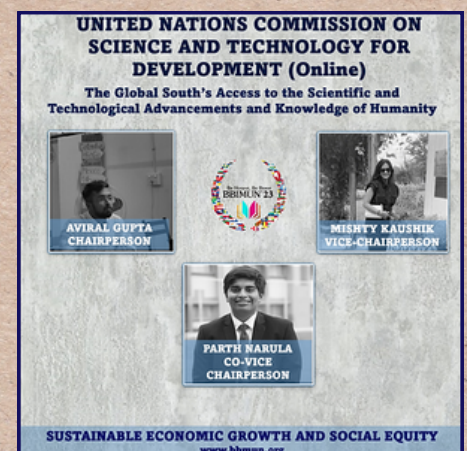

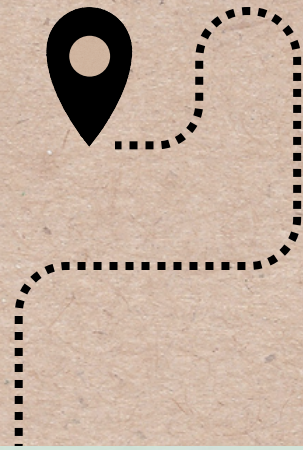


INTERNATIONAL ONLINE UNDRR COMMITTEE

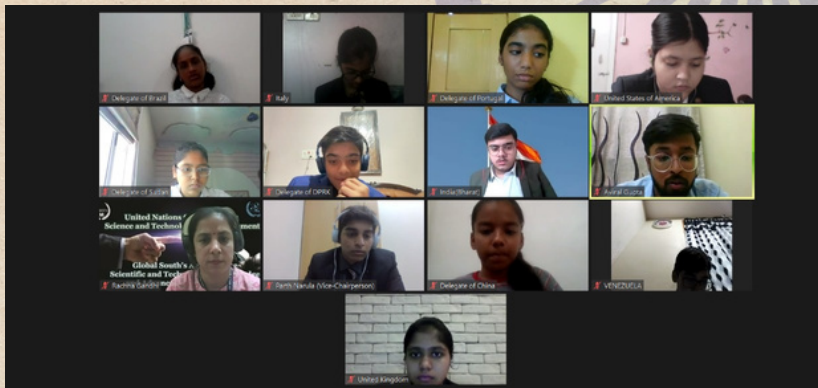

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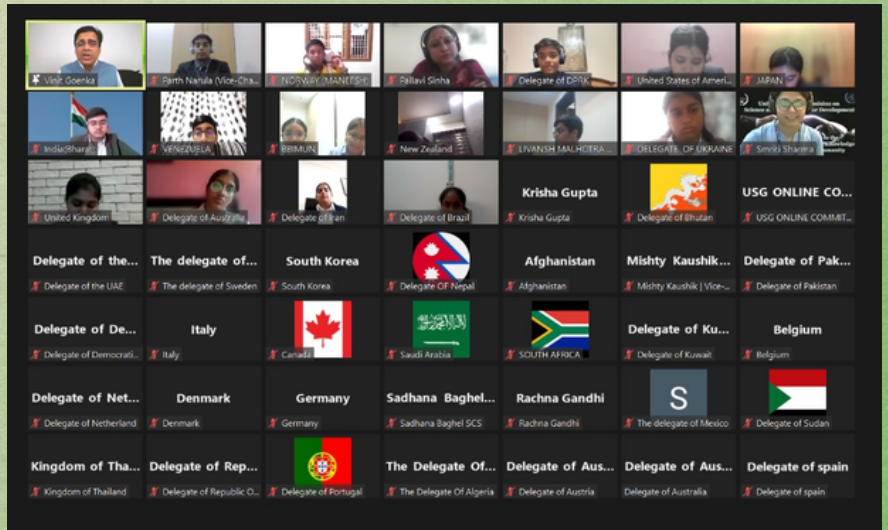
